

**AMENDMENT TO DOCUMENT BT-16**

In document 'BT-16 – Temporary Monitoring' an additional monitoring concerning the research of Aflatoxin B1 in maize, has been implemented. Such monitoring must be implemented by all GMP operators concerned.

The changes in this document relate to the following points:

- **India has been added to the list of origins which are definitely concerned** by the problem of Aflatoxin in maize;
- Modification of the **maximum authorized dimension of a batch** for seagoing vessels (max 2000 tons);
- Modification as regards the **wording** of the example mentioned in the table "Validity of an analysis" (point 5).
