## OVOCOM publishes a specific module in order to comply with the requirements by the Dutch Dairy companies

In order to maintain its leading position in the international dairy community, the Dutch dairy industry has, since January 1, 2016, further tightened the quality assurance of animal feed within the Netherlands. To this end, the NZO manages the so-called "White List". Only companies listed on the white list may directly supply feed to Dutch dairy farmers.

In response to the requirements laid down by the Dutch dairy industry, OVOCOM has, in addition to the Feed Chain Alliance Standard, developed a specific module, intended for FCA certified companies wishing to supply Dutch dairy farmers, namely Module I-01: Direct delivery to Dutch dairy farmers'. Ovocom has, in accordance with the Dutch requirements, highlighted all the supplier-product combinations and carried out an associated risk assessment. Based on the latter, as of July 1, 2016, specific supplier audits shall be carried out in the context of this module I-01. When the implementation of this module is fully operational, FCA certified companies will receive a final approval for the delivery to Dutch dairy farmers. As regards the mention on the white list, this shall mean that animal feed companies who, in 2015, had a valid FCA certificate and are applying the module shall be listed on the white lists.
